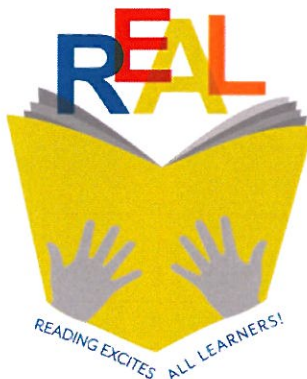


1 Volunteer + 1 Child + 1 Hour = REAL Success
